



Janet Rothenberg Memorial Scholarship



The Janet Rothenberg Memorial Scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with the annual Janet Rothenberg Memorial meet hosted by United Sports Academy.

High school senior gymnasts are eligible who:

- Are nominated by their coach
- Are in her senior year of high school
- Plan on attending a college, university or trade school next year
- Must be a member of USAG Trampoline & Tumbling Program
- Must compete in the 2023 Janet Rothenberg Memorial Meet.

One \$2,500 scholarship will be given. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the college, university, or trade school the recipient is attending upon presentation of a tuition bill to United Sports Academy.

To all coaches from the Janet Rothenberg Memorial T&T Meet Scholarship Committee:

The 2023 Janet Rothenberg Memorial meet will be held on January 15th, 2023.

During this time one senior will be awarded a \$2,500 scholarship in memory of Janet.

The criterion for receiving this scholarship is based on:

- Academic Excellence
- Community Involvement
- Athletic Achievement

The nomination of a gymnast for this award should be made by you, her coach. The criteria relates to what was important to Janet during her lifetime. We are asking you and your athlete to complete the brief application below and submit it to us at usacademytt@gmail.com by December 16, 2022.

The recipient will be announced Sunday evening at the meet. While it is strongly encouraged that all applicants plan on attending the Saturday evening session for the award presentation, the recipient need not be present to accept the award.
